

MANDARIN CHINESE

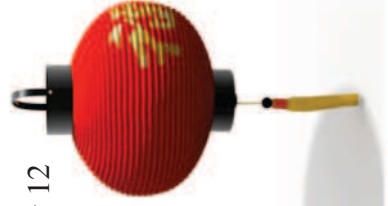
Incoming 6th, 7th & 8th Graders

COURSE DESCRIPTION

During the first week-long session, students will be exposed to Chinese phonics and writing systems. The instructor will demonstrate the significance of tones and radicals being used by the language. Activities and foods related to major Chinese festivals will be introduced. Major events in Chinese history for the past 2500 years will be discussed. During the second week-long session, students will be doing hands-on activities to experience learning Chinese in a classroom, writing characters using brush pens, using musical instruments to create music, participating in cultural celebrations and doing Chinese physical exercises.
