**Blue: Worlds of Wisdom and Wonder** (Extended Care offered mornings only)

**Red: Summer Wonders** (Extended Care offered mornings and afternoons)

**Green: Project '18** (3-week program for older students)

**Fuchsia: Tinker-a-Thon (TAT)** (A single, self-contained, student-centered classroom)

At all summer programs, students enroll for either the half day (morning or afternoon) or the full day for the duration of the program. The daily schedule for most students is two classes each morning and/or two each afternoon; students choose their own courses from a variety of exciting topics.

Additional program details will be added above and to our website as they are confirmed.

Applicants who have attended previous programs of The Center for Gifted are accepted upon application as space allows. Teacher recommendations are required for applicants who have not attended a previous program. More information is provided on our summer 2018 teacher recommendation form, which can be found on our website or emailed or mailed upon request. The completed and signed recommendation form may be submitted via fax, mail, or email, before, with, or after application.

There are no application deadlines. Enrollment remains open for each program until it begins or until the program is full; some programs have limited enrollment.

A deposit of at least \$80 must accompany application for all programs except Project '18, which requires a \$150 deposit. Tuition and fees are fully refundable for withdrawals requested from any program before it begins. Financial assistance is available for our summer programs. Please contact us for the application.
