Dear Parents,

Over the past several weeks, the school administration and school board have been working hard to finalize the 2018-2019 school year budget and tuition. After much review and reflection on the school budget, fundraising, and the tuition of other Catholic schools in the area, the tuition for next school year is as follows:

One child	\$4,980	Three children	\$11,650
Two children	\$8,500	Four children	\$14,250

The parish continues to support the school and contributes a significant portion of the budget. That contribution helps keep our tuition as low as possible. We are truly blessed to be a part of the St. Isidore community where we all come together to support each other, in academics, worship and friendship. Your contributions to the parish and the school support our community and help minimize tuition increases.

In continuing with our support of our technology program and our commitment to not increase the technology fee for the first 3 years, each child in kindergarten through eighth grade will be assessed a technology fee of \$100. The maximum technology fee per family will be \$300. The technology fee can be included as part of your tuition payments through FACTS. Based on the 10 installments FACTS plan, the technology fee is \$10 per child, per month.

It is also important for all of us to contribute to school events and fundraising to keep our tuition increases low and meet the requirements from the diocese. **To better balance out one of the fundraising events in this next year, we will be requiring 4 Grand Raffle tickets to be pre-purchased per family for a cost of \$200.** As in years past, these tickets can be sold and we encourage parents to sell these tickets to involve their family, friends and neighbors in the support of the school. **The primary reason we are doing this is to get full involvement in this fundraiser and avoid needing to add additional fundraisers. This past year we had almost 60% of families not sell a single raffle ticket.** We need to have a better balance and involvement from everyone on this.

As always, thank you for everything you do for the school and parish. St. Isidore is a great community as a result of all of the individual efforts and talents that each of you bring to the school each and every day.
