The board helps form policies, which give direction to the programs in the school within the guidelines and regulations, established by the Joliet Diocesan Schools Office and the Joliet Diocesan School Board. School Board members serve a three-year term.

School Board members act as liaisons and may introduce topics of general interest and concern among school families. The Board has open monthly board meetings held in the Parish Upper Conference meeting room on the 4th Tuesday of every month at 7pm. Some of the Board duties include but are not limited to:

- Participation in the following committees: Development, Communication, Finance, Legislative, Recruitment and Alumni relations.
- Discuss and approve tuition rates and fundraising activities.
- Participate in various events, such as the 3-on-3, Clothing Sales, Gala, Chips and Chili and Open House.
- Attend School Board sponsored all-school meetings, such as the State of the School meeting.
- Discuss information provided by HSA and the Athletic Board, both of which report to school board.
