Tuition Payment Options

There are three options for paying tuition, once you enroll in our electronic payment processing (FACTS) system.

You may elect to make one payment to be paid on or before August 5, 2020. Full tuition paid on or before August 5, 2020 will result in a 3% discount off tuition (not fees). You may make tuition payments in two installments with installments being due on or before August 5th and January 5th. Tuition payments may also be paid monthly over a 10-month period and is due on the 5th or the 20th of each month beginning in August and ending in May.
